**Lesson: Isaiah 28-33 - How Firm the Foundation**

During a time of crisis, the prophet Isaiah calls for the people to rest their security and future on the firm foundation of God's plans.

- I. Isaiah 28-33 represent the message Isaiah spoke in Jerusalem in the days leading up to and during the Assyrian siege.
- II. The word "woe" provides unity and structure to this section.
  - a. Each "woe" introduces a threat followed by God's promise.
  - b. The "woe" connotes a sense of sadness and grief.
- III. The six woes:

Woe 1	Isa. 28:1-28	Build on the firm foundation of the Lord of Hosts not the drunken leaders of Jerusalem.
Woe 2	Isa. 29:1-14	Draw near to God for complete protection.
Woe 3	Isa. 29: 15-29	God is the potter the people are the clay.
Woe 4	Isa. 30:1-26	Hear the instruction of the Lord.
Woe 5	Isa. 31:1-32:20	Jerusalem receives God's spirit.
Woe 6	Isa. 33:1-24	The Lord is exalted for he dwells on high.
